Authors should bring poster (maximum size of A1) and .ppt on the day of symposium according to their presentation type.

All submissions will be added to the proceedings of the symposium (ISBN: 978-4-9907633-2-9). Selected papers will be published in Journal of Korean Society for Geospatial Information Sciences (KCI; pISSN: 1598-2955, eISSN: 2287-6693) with the slightly modification and extension to avoid the plagiarism, free of cost after peer-review.
